Regulations

A letter of introduction is required.

Our facilities are available to both ladies and gentlemen.

Partners and guests of your members are welcome in both the castle restaurant and the pool restaurant.

At the castle a jacket is required. For the other locations, simple but elegant attire is required (smart casual).

Our swimming pool is accessible for your members and their partners from Monday to Thursday from 8 am to 8 pm and on Friday from 8 am to 4 pm / not on weekends or public holidays.

Period: max. 10 days/year.

As a member of an associated club, access is free. However, accompanying persons must pay the guest rate (12€/child, 24€/adult from 18 years old).

Additional fees are charged for booking a tennis or padel court.

Gratuities to the staff are not allowed.
